Against this background, a small group of women rose up to try to save Louisa's life, arguing that a legal system comprised only of men -- male judges, all-male jury, male prosecutor, governor and Premier -- could not with any integrity hang a woman. The tenacity of these women would not save Louisa but it would ultimately carry women from their homes all the way to Parliament House. The author went on to say that women could be just as violent and aggressive as men; the idea that women are defenseless and need men's protection is probably the last vestige of institutionalized sexism that needs to be rubbed out.
