Pure Soldiers or Bloodthirsty Murderers traces the 14th Waffen-SS Galicia Division's fortunes from its formation in April 1943, to its surrender to the British in May 1946, from immigrant farm workers in Britain, Canada and the USA, to Cold War CIA assassins. Along the way, it attempts to shed some light on this acrimonious dispute that has continued to the present day. Sol Littman is former Canadian Director of the Simon Wiesenthal Center, author of *War Criminal on Trial*, founding editor of *The Canadian Jewish News*, the First Director of B'nai Brith Canada's League for Human Rights, and also served with the Anti-Defamation League in the United States.

Galicia Division Michael O. Logusz, 1997 This new book is a historical account of the 14th Waffen-SS Galicia Division (also known as the 1st Ukrainian Division of the Ukrainian National Army). Breaking the Chains Carlos Caballero Jurado, 1998 *BREAKING THE CHAINS* is a full account of the 14th Waffen-SS Division, formed by Ukrainians, initially from the province of Galicia but later encompassing the whole of the Ukraine. The history of this unit is set upon a particularly full discussion of the political background of the Ukraine, especially the Ukrainian nationalist movements of the post-World War 1 period. These movements, especially the OUN (Organisation of Ukrainian Nationalists), were fundamental in providing the basis for the new division being for the creation of two early Ukrainian formations (Roland and Nachtigall battalions) which fought at the outset of the Russian campaign. After the German take-over in the Ukraine, many other units were set up, notably the German Police 'Schuma' battalions and many German Army volunteer units, generically termed Osttruppen (East Troops). These units are also fully covered in the book - as far as information is available. However, in the later German political system in the major part of the Ukraine, the oppressive policies of Reichskommissar Erich Koch eventually led to much anti-German feeling and the setting up of local partisan forces, most prominently in the form of the UPA. It is this destructive policy by some, but certainly not all German

officials which the author argues was a major factor in the eventual German defeat. The book concludes with the immediate post-war agonies of the Ukrainian nationalist movement in the face of the horrific Stalinist dictatorship. A full set of appendices are included, covering all known Ukrainian units in the German ground forces, rank and appointment terms in the SS, Police, German Government etc., and the usual Shelf Books treatment of foreign placenames. All in all, this book constitutes a complete history of the Ukrainian involvement in World War II - a Story of tragedy, Disappointment and, on the German side, What would appear to be gross stupidity.

The Ukrainian Division "Galicia," 1943-45 Wolf-Dietrich Heike, 1988 As the Division's Chief of Staff from January 1944 until its ultimate surrender in May 1945, the author was in an exceptionally favorable position to observe how a large group of Ukrainians reacted to the impending and politically complex crisis on the Eastern Front. The author describes the Division as it was formed in May 1943 and first saw action in July 1944 at Brody, where the major portion of its troops were killed or captured by Soviet forces. In October it was sent to Slovakia and was stationed there until January 1945. Then, by arduous marches under extremely difficult conditions, it was transferred to the mixed nationality area of southern Austria and northern Slovenia. At the war's end the Division retreated farther into Austria, to surrender to the British Army. Most combat was with regular Soviet troops advancing through Hungary toward southeast Austria. Major Heike delineates these operations skillfully and graphically. The memoir is especially valuable for his account of the campaign in Styria - likely to remain the principal source of information on the Division's activities during the last months of World War Two - as well as for the light it sheds on numerous other aspects of Ukrainian involvement in the war.--

The Waffen-SS Jochen Böhrer, Robert Gerwarth, 2016-12-01 This is the first systematic pan-European study of the hundreds of thousands of non-Germans who fought — either voluntarily or under different kinds of pressures — for the Waffen-SS (or auxiliary police formations operating in the occupied East). Fated to Defeat Lukasz Gladysiak, 2019-11-19 33. Waffen-Grenadier Division der SS was one of a number of divisions in the Third Reich's armed forces composed of foreign soldiers. The majority that formed this unit were French: volunteers or men who, because of collaboration, had been forced to help the German's on the eve of the Allied invasion in Western Europe. During February-March 1945 the French division took part in the struggle for Pomerania, facing overwhelming Soviet and Polish Forces. The unit fought in a constant retreat and met its fate during the few days of battle in Białogard (former Belgard an der Persante) and Karlino (Koerlin) region. Łukasz Gładysiak's book is the first attempt by a Polish author to accurately recreate these episodes of the last stages of 33. Waffen-Grenadier Division der SS's history. Collecting historical sources from all over Europe, including German Army Group Vistula's documents, and memories of veterans of both sides of the frontline largely unpublished so far, the author takes us to the fields, towns and villages of Pomerania during the tragic days of the beginning of 1945, and follows the battle through the towns of Czarne (Hammerstein)-Czluchów (Schlochau), Szczecinek (Neustettin), Białogard (Belgardan der Persante), Karlino (Koerlin) i Kołobrzeg (Kolberg). While the chronological description of the combat forms the backbone of this book, the individual soldiers' stories, including biographies of key figures, as well as a number of previously unsolved mysteries are also covered, such as the fate of General Edgar Puaud. This is the first book that refers extensively to the French SS-men's battles in Pomerania in the last stages of the Third Reich.

There, east of Berlin, the division participated in the final battles to enable the escape of German soldiers and civilians from Soviet captivity.

Voices of the Waffen SS Gerry Villani, 2019-03-15 The Waffen SS were Hitler's elite forces during WWII. They were the forces that were feared by the enemy and praised by their allies.
