Equestrian Rebels Roberto Cantú, 2016-05-11 Mariano Azuela (Mexico, 1873-1952) was a medical doctor by profession, recipient of Mexico's Premio Nacional de Literatura (1949), a distinguished member of El Colegio Nacional and, by mid-century, one of Mexico's leading novelists and literary critics. Fue Presidente del Instituto de Reformas Sociales desde su creación (1903), aunque esta entidad traía causa de la Comisión formada en 1893 y en la que Azcárate también fue referente esencial. Su condición de hombre preocupado por la realidad de su tiempo, le llevó a pensar teóricamente sobre sus problemas que él llamaba cuestiones: la religiosa, la social y la política pero, además, a buscar soluciones prácticas en el complejo escenario político en el que desarrolló su vida. Por eso, su presencia en el Congreso de los Diputados fue tan importante. Fue un parlamentario en el sentido amplio del término, tanto como legislador como fiscalizador de la labor del gobierno e impulsor de la acción política de su partido o proyecto coyuntural y es que, en paralelo a su labor como diputado, tuvo una presencia permanente en todos los proyectos de avance democrático que se plantearon desde la moderación republicana y la reforma accidentalista.
