Die Münzen und Medaillen von Hamburg und Bremen Manfred Miller,2020-09-03 Die beiden Hansestädte Bremen und Hamburg haben eine lange und wechselvolle Geschichte mit einer entsprechend vielfältigen Münzprägung. Entsprechend groß ist das numismatische Interesse. Im Jahr 834 wurden in Hamburg erstmals Münzen geschlagen. Das Münzrecht, verliehen durch den Kaiser, hatte der Erzbischof zu Hammaburg inne. Später verkauften die Grafen von Holstein ihre Münzstätte an die Stadt Hamburg, der damit erlaubt war, eigene Münzen zu schlagen. Dabei handelte es sich überwiegend um Brakteaten. 1435 wurde der Hamburgischen Münze das Recht zur Prägung von Goldmünzen, den Gulden, durch Kaiser Sigismund verliehen. 1553 wurden in der Münzstätte erstmals Taler und Portugaleser geprägt. Am 24. Mai 1541 erteilte Kaiser Karl V. der Stadt Bremen 1541 das Privileg, Münzen zu prägen und in Umlauf zu bringen. Nun wurden Goldgulden, Taler in verschiedenen Werten und andere Sorten nach der Reichsmünzordnung geprägt, ohne dass, wie auch sonst im Norden, deren Vorschriften im Detail eingehalten worden wären. Für den lokalen Zahlungsverkehr wurden weiterhin Grote und Sware geprägt. Die 2-Grote-Stücke entsprachen dem Groschen der Münzordnung des niedersächsischen Reichskreises, der die damals oberste Münzaufsicht übernommen hatte. Bis auf Witten und Sware tragen die Bremer Münzen nun auf der Rückseite die Symbole des Reichs. Durch die Vielzahl der umlaufenden Sorten und ihre ständig wechselnden Umrechnungen war das Münzwesen nicht nur in Bremen verworren. Grundlage des Handels war der einigermaßen zuverlässig ausgemünzte Reichstaler. Grote und Schwaren blieben bis 1872 die gängigen bremischen Scheidemünzen. Am 1. Juli 1872 verlor Bremen seine Münzhoheit im Zuge der Gründung des Deutschen Kaiserreichs.

Gewichtsstandardisierung in der Antike Stefan Bergdoll, 2023-10-04 Zuerst werden die Anfänge der Metrologie beleuchtet, die mit den beiden frühen Hochkulturen Ägypten und Sumer verbunden sind. Es werden ausgehend von den ersten Gewichtssystemen beider Kulturen die Fortentwicklung bis ins erste vorchristliche Jahrtausend aufgezeigt. Das 2. Kap. beschäftigt sich mit China und dessen Standardisierungsbestrebungen. Das 3. Im 4. Kap. wird auf Gewichtsstandards des altpersischen Reiches, auch Achämenidenreich genannt, eingegangen. Es erstreckte sich vom späten 6. Jh. v. Chr. bis ins späte 4. Jh. v. Chr. über die Gebiete der heutigen Staaten Türkei, Zypern, Iran, Irak, Afghanistan, Usbekistan, Tadschikistan, Turkmenistan, Syrien, Libanon, Israel, Palästina und Ägypten. Das 5. Kap. enthält Untersuchungen zum römischen Pfund, der libra, deren Wert zu 324 g bestimmt werden konnte. Das 6. Kap. widmet sich den Gewichtsstandards in Zentraleuropa und Kleinasien in der Bronzezeit. Hierin geht es um Zahlungsmittel, wie Ochsenhautbarren aus Kupfer, die hauptsächlich aus dem Mittelmeerraum (Kreta, Zypern, etc.) stammen, sowie um bronzene Ösenhalsringe der Aunjetitzer Kultur (Frühbronzezeit). Das 7. Kap. widmet sich der Entwicklung der Münzen als Gewichtsstandard und Zahlungsmittel. Die erste Gliederungsebene in diesem Kap. bildet die Zeit (Antike, Mittelalter, Hochmittelalter bis Moderne und Moderne). Die zweite Gliederungsebene betrifft die Region oder die Münze. Dabei werden Zusammenhänge und Entwicklungen beim Münzwesen unterschiedlicher Nationen von der Antike bis in die Moderne besprochen. Viele Entwicklungen basieren auf dem römischen Gewichtssystem, aber nicht alle. Jh. geprägt vermutlich unter dem damaligen Herrscher Alyattes II. Es sind Stater-Münzen aus Elektron und Bruchteile davon. In Griechenland begann man im 6. Jh. die Drachme als Münzwährung einzuführen. Die mit ihrer Eule als Bild für Athen typisch wurde und noch heute in unserem Sprichwort Eulen nach Athen tragen enthalten ist. Zwei Drachmen waren dem Gewicht

nach einem Stater gleich. Als Prägmaterial nutzte man in Griechenland Gold, Silber und Bronze. Der Bronze-Chalkous aus dem 1. Jh. n. Chr. wog gerade einmal 0,1 g. In Indien prägte man zeitgleich zu den Griechen eigene Münzen. Goldmünzen waren Niṣka und Suvarṇa/Dīnāra. Silbermünzen waren Rati, Māṣaka, Śāṇa, Rūpaka/Dramma, Puraṇa/Dhāraṇa/Kārṣāpaṇa, Viṃśatika, Śatamāna und Dhānaka. Kupfermünzen waren: Kārṣāpaṇa/Paṇa, Kākiṇī und Māṣa. Dazu gab es noch Muschelgeld, genau wie in China im 2. Jt. v. Chr. In China nutzte man zu Beginn auch Ringgeld und Spatenmünze, Messermünzen, sowie Ameisen-Nasen-Münzen. Im 4. Jh. v. Chr. wurden die ersten runden Münzen in China hergestellt, welche meist ein viereckiges Loch in der Mitte besaßen; es waren Käschen-Münzen. Im römischen Reich gab es folgende Münzen: As, Dupondius, Denar, Sesterz, Aureus, Argenteus, Siliqua, Miliarense, Solidus und Tremissis, sowie Nummus. In islamischen Gebieten entstanden im 7. Jh. n. Chr. die Dinar- und Dirhem-Münzen.
