**Historia de la España Medieval** Monsalvo Antón, José María, 2018-12-22 [4.<sup>a</sup> ed. 2023] El proyecto de Historia de España Digital de la Universidad de Salamanca se estructura en varias etapas, concretadas en otros tantos volúmenes. El que ahora ofrecemos es el referido al período medieval, que lleva por título Historia de la España medieval. Este coordinador piensa que no merece siquiera justificar la idoneidad de un título que incluye un término, España, ante el que algunos todavía muestran reticencias. Es sabido que estas han nacido de prejuicios aventurados y puramente ideológicos o bien de un desconocimiento tanto de la propia Edad Media y sus discursos de identidad colectiva como de la tradición historiográfica contemporánea. Ni Alfonso X tuvo reparo alguno a la hora de escribir una extraordinaria Estoria de España, de igual modo que antes se había hablado De Rebus Hispaniae, ni los mejores medievalistas de los siglos XIX, XX y XXI han hallado objeción seria para referirse a la realidad histórica de España en aquel período, más allá de un obvio reconocimiento de la pluralidad de estados y reinos que existían en la época, como es bien sabido. La Historia de la España medieval recorre un largo lapso cronológico, que arranca en la Tardoantigüedad y llega hasta la época de los Reyes Católicos, abarcando así el período histórico desde el 400 al 1500 aproximadamente. Se han estructurado los capítulos más o menos temáticamente pero dentro de tres grandes ámbitos cronológicos, la Alta, la Plena y la Baja Edad Media. Con algunas matizaciones, eso sí. Por ejemplo, la época hispanovisigoda se considera etapa previa a la Alta Edad Media propiamente dicha. Mientras que el último capítulo, que es un complemento sobre la Edad Media a través de la arqueología, tampoco se corresponde, como es lógico, con una etapa determinada de la Edad Media. Y en cuanto a la historia de Al-Ándalus se ha estructurado en dos, y no tres, períodos, a diferencia de la compartimentación ternaria de los reinos y territorios cristianos. Los autores de los capítulos son los profesores de la Facultad de Geografía e Historia de la Universidad de Salamanca adscritos al Área de Historia Medieval: Fernando Luis Corral, José Luis Martín Martín, Iñaki Martín Viso, José María Monsalvo Antón, Luis Serrano-Piedecabras Fernández, Soledad Tena García y Ángel Vaca Lorenzo. En los dos capítulos que cada uno ha asumido, el autor ha redactado el texto, buscado imágenes, enlaces y bibliografía. La disponibilidad de recursos, sobre todo en red, es muy diferente según los temas. Los aspectos de tipo económico y social son los que han ofrecido más dificultad a la hora de encontrar imágenes o

enlaces pertinentes y expresivos. Es preciso al respecto mencionar la ayuda que para mejorar este déficit en tales casos ha prestado Raúl Moreno Almendral, brillante becario de colaboración del Departamento de Historia Medieval, Moderna y Contemporánea e historiador ya, pues acaba de culminar su licenciatura con unos resultados académicos espectaculares, solo comparables a su compromiso y seriedad como buen colaborador en la obra.

El tiempo histórico a considerar discurre desde mediados del siglo XIII hasta comienzos del XVI y, como e el primer volumen, se ofrece una amplia guía bibliográfica clasificada por materias para dar a conocer el estado de las investigaciones y gran parte de las publicaciones especializadas.

*Alfonso el Sabio y la conceptualización jurídica de la monarquía en las 'Siete Partidas'* Mechthild Albert,Ulrike Becker,Elmar Schmidt,2021-06-07 Las 'Siete Partidas', compendio jurídico recopilado por encargo de Alfonso X de Castilla (1221-1284), sientan las bases de un influyente concepto de gobierno monárquico. Estas se enmarcan en el periodo de impulso a la normalización jurídica característico del siglo XIII en Europa Occidental ('Magna Carta', 'Espejo Sajón', 'Liber augustalis' e.a.). **Spanish Society, 1400-1600** Teofilo F Ruiz, 2014-09-11 Spanish Society depicts a complex and fascinating country in transition from the late Middle Ages to modernity. It describes every part of society from the gluttonous nobility to their starving peasants. Through anecdotes, a lively style and portraits of figures such as St Teresa of Avila and Torquemada, the book reflects the character and humour with which the common Spaniard endured an often-wretched lot. In the premodern period, such solutions were characterised by two factors in particular: on the one hand, the entry of two countries into a union did not constitute a military annexation — even though claims to the throne were all too often imposed by force; on the other hand, the new unitarian constellation retained, at least de jure, the independence of its respective components. The twenty-four essays, ranging in scope from Scandinavia to Iberia, from England and France to Central and Eastern Europe, examine whether the respective unions were the result of careful planning and deliberations in the face of a long-foreseen succession crisis or whether they emerged from dynamic developments that were largely reactive and dependent upon various random factors and circumstances. Each union is assessed to provide an understanding, for students and researchers, of the political and social forces involved in the respective countries and investigates how the unions were reflected in contemporary literature (pamphlets, memoranda, chronicles, diaries etc.), propaganda and in legal and historical discourses. This volume is essential reading for students and researchers interested in the history of monarchy, political history and social and cultural histories in premodern Europe.

**El lugar del campesino** Ana Rodríguez López, 2011-11-28 Múltiple ha estat per a Reyna Pastor el lloc del camperol. Ha estat un lloc físic, on conrear i on habitar, però també un lloc als boscos i als erms; un espai de lluita i de cooperació, un lloc social: en la comunitat i en les estructures familiars, a les xarxes del poder feudal i en les formes de solidaritat local. Ha estat

un lloc construït des del conflicte i la resistència, en la identitat -o, molt millor, en la consciència de classe- i en la diferenciació interna; des de baix, atribuint a la comunitat, a la família i al camperol mateix la capacitat d'elaborar estratègies i d'utilitzar recursos propis, no només d'encaixar com a subjecte inerte l'acció senyorial. Identificar problemes, replantejar preguntes, aplicar una nova mirada a camins trillats, desbrossar les fonts, enriquir els models d'anàlisi, posar-los en moviment i treure a la llum les seues forces interiors, han estat els moments clau en el procés de reflexió històrica que, contracorrent en alguns moments, va emprendre Reyna Pastor fa ja molts anys. Reyna Pastor (Buenos Aires, 1925), descendent directa d'espanyols i alumna de Claudio Sánchez Albornoz, ha estat professora a la Universitat de Buenos Aires, en la càtedra d'Història Social, ocupada per José Luis Romero, i a la Universitat Nacional de Rosario. En aquella època, en la qual va viatjar amb freqüència a Europa, va ser becària en l'École donis Hautes Études en Sciences Sociales i professora associada a la Universitat d'Aix a Provençe, en el departament dirigit per Georges Duby. De la seua etapa argentina destaquen les obres 'Conflictos sociales y estancamiento económico en la España medieval' i 'Del Islam al Cristianismo. En las fronteras de dos formaciones económico-sociales: Toledo, siglos XI-XIII'. Després del cop d'estat militar, Reyna Pastor va emprendre el 1976, com tants altres argentins, el camí de l'exili polític, deixant a Argentina nombrosos deixebles. Des de llavors rau en Espanya, on ha estat professora de la Facultat d'Econòmiques de la Universitat Complutense de Madrid i, des de 1987, del departament d'Història Medieval del Centre d'Estudis Històrics del CSIC, institució de la qual havia sortit, cinquanta anys enrere, Claudio Sánchez Albornoz camí de l'exili argentí. De la seua etapa espanyola destaquen 'Resistencias y luchas campesinas en la época del crecimiento y consolidación de la formación feudal', l'obra que més influència ha exercit en el medievalisme espanyol, i tres llibres de treball en equip, un d'ells, 'Transacciones sin mercado. Instituciones, propiedad y redes sociales en Galicia', traduït a l'anglès.

El lugar del campesino Ana Rodríguez, 2007 Múltiple ha sido para Reyna Pastor el lugar del campesino. Ha sido un lugar físico, donde cultivar y donde habitar, pero también un lugar en los bosques y en los baldíos; un espacio de lucha y de cooperación, un lugar social: en la comunidad y en las estructuras familiares, en las redes del poder feudal y en las formas de solidaridad local. Ha sido un lugar construido desde el conflicto y la resistencia, en la identidad -o, mucho mejor, en la conciencia de clase- y en la diferenciación interna; desde abajo, atribuyendo a la comunidad, a la familia y al campesino mismo la capacidad de elaborar estrategias y de utilizar recursos propios, no sólo de encajar como sujeto inerte la acción señorial. Todos estos aspectos pueden haberse convertido en tópicos en exceso manidos a estas alturas del siglo, pero no lo eran en absoluto hace treinta años, y menos aún en el seno de la historiografía sobre la Edad Media hispana. Identificar problemas, replantear preguntas, aplicar una nueva mirada a caminos trillados, desbrozar las fuentes, enriquecer los

modelos de análisis, ponerlos en movimiento y sacar a la luz sus fuerzas interiores, han sido los jalones en el proceso de reflexión histórica que, contracorriente en algunos momentos, emprendió Reyna Pastor hace ya muchos años. Reyna Pastor (Buenos Aires, 1925), descendiente directa de españoles y alumna de Claudio Sánchez Albornoz, ha sido profesora en la Universidad de Buenos Aires, en la cátedra de Historia Social, ocupada por José Luis Romero, y en la Universidad Nacional de Rosario. En esa época, en la que viajó con frecuencia a Europa, fue becaria en la École des Hautes Études en Sciences Sociales y profesora asociada en la Universidad de Aix en Provence, en el departamento dirigido por Georges Duby. De su etapa argentina destacan las obras “Conflictos sociales y estancamiento económico en la España medieval” y “Del Islam al Cristianismo. En las fronteras de dos formaciones económico-sociales: Toledo, siglos XI-XIII”. Tras el golpe de estado militar, Reyna Pastor emprendió en 1976, como tantos otros argentinos, el camino del exilio político, dejando en Argentina numerosos discípulos. Desde entonces reside en España, donde ha sido profesora de la Facultad de Económicas de la Universidad Complutense de Madrid y, desde 1987, del Departamento de Historia Medieval del Centro de Estudios Históricos del CSIC, institución de la que había salido, cincuenta años atrás, Claudio Sánchez Albornoz camino del exilio argentino. De su etapa española destacan “Resistencias y luchas campesinas en la época del crecimiento y consolidación de la formación feudal”, la obra que más influencia ha ejercido en el medievalismo español, y tres libros de trabajo en equipo, uno de ellos, “Transacciones sin mercado. Instituciones, propiedad y redes sociales en Galicia”, traducido al inglés.
