Eros Rosaura Martínez Ruiz,2021-10-05 Eros considers a promise left unfulfilled in Sigmund Freud's Beyond the Pleasure Principle. Dead Labor James Tyner,2019-03-12 A groundbreaking consideration of death from capitalism, from the seventeenth to the twenty-first century From a 2013 Texas fertilizer plant explosion that killed fifteen people and injured 252 to a 2017 chemical disaster in the wake of Hurricane Harvey, we are confronted all too often with industrial accidents that reflect the

underlying attitude of corporations toward the lives of laborers and others who live and work in their companies' shadows. Dead Labor takes seriously the myriad ways in which bodies are commodified and profits derived from premature death.
