Jean Michel Basquiat (1960-1988). One of the great visual artists of the second half of the 20th century was born and raised in Brooklyn. He first gained fame as a graffiti artist, tagging with a partner under the name SAMO, and his major breakthrough as a painter came in 1981 at a group show in New York City. Basquiat was originally seen as being part of New York's neo-expressionist movement, but his distinct and highly individualistic approach to making art defied categorization. In a relatively short space of time, his work became highly sought after by collectors, exhibited in the United States and Europe, and he somewhat reluctantly became the new face of the city's thriving 1980s art scene.
